2023 Hickory Motor Speedway Late Model Stock Car Playoffs

Overview

- Total # of Regular Season Events/ Weekends will be 13. The regular season event weekends will run from March 4th until the regular season finale on August 5th.
- Post Season Playoff Eligibility
 - O Drivers must compete in at least 8 of the 13 regular season event weekends from March 4th to August 5th to be eligible for playoffs
 - There will be no limit to the # of drivers allowed in the <u>4-race end of season</u> playoff as long as they have competed in 8 of 13 regular season event weekends
 - Rainouts (if any) will not offset the total number of events to be completed), the number or required events for eligibility will still remain 8

Regular Season Points/Champion

• During the first 13 events, the regular season champion will be determined by total number of points scored with the following points system, the same points system that HMS has used over the last several years.

Playoff Seeding

- Playoff Seeding will be determined by the following order:
 - Total Points Scored in the 13 regular season events for eligible drivers that have competed on at least 8 of the 13 weekends
 - Reseeding will be based on traditional regular season points, with win & pole bonus points to be added to the Championship Playoff Points (see below bullet points for win & pole bonus points)
- Any regular season race win will add a +2 Point bonus to your playoff seeding total after the end of the regular season
- Any regular season race pole will add a +1 Point bonus to your **playoff seeding total** after the end of the regular season (bonus points will not be issued for pole positions after the invert)
- Last 4 races will be ran "straight up" with the same regular season points system **in addition** to win and pole bonus points.
